- 7. The fool sins. (Prov. 10:23; 14:9)
- 8. The fool sees no need for <u>counsel</u>. (Prov. 12:15)
- 9. The fool has no desire to learn God's word. (Prov. 23:9)
- 10. The fool becomes a grief to his parents. (Prov. 17:25)
- 11. A fool does right when <u>forced</u>. (Prov. 26:3)
- 12. A fool repeats same folly. (Prov. 26:11)
