2. Simple means inexperienced. (Prov. 9:1-6)
3. There is no sin in being a simple Christian, but it is sin to remain simple. (Prov. 19:7)
4. The foolish is without aim.
5. The foolish is opposed to those who walk uprightly.
6. The foolish lacks character.
7. The foolish is easily offended, impulsive, and makes quick decisions.

7. The fool sins. (Prov. 10:23; 14:9)
8. The fool sees no need for counsel. (Prov. 12:15)
9. The fool has no desire to learn God's word. (Prov. 23:9)
10. The fool becomes a grief to his parents. (Prov. 17:25)
11. A fool does right when forced. (Prov. 26:3)
12. A fool repeats same folly. (Prov. 26:11)
