- V. Sin diseases the body. (vs. 8)
 - A. Sin in your life, without repentance, can actually make your body sick.
 - B. Joy works like medicine, misery works like poison. (Pr. 17:22)
- VI. C. Our bodies will react to our hearts, minds and spirits.
- VII. Sin defiles the spirit. (vs. 10)
 - A. You will have a sour spirit.
 - B. You will have a critical spirit.
