Introduction

1. Sin dirties the soul. (vs. 1-2)
2. Sin dominates the mind. (vs. 3)
3. Sin disgraces the Lord. (vs. 4)
4. Sin depresses the heart. (vs. 8)
5. Sin diseases the body. (vs. 8)
6. Sin defiles the spirit. (vs. 10)
7. Sin destroys the testimony. (vs. 14)

I. Confidence.

- A. Know that for a multitude of sins, there are multitude of mercies. (vs. 1)
- B. God does not love us because we are valuable; we are valuable because He loves us. (Rom. 5:8)
- C. There is nothing you can do to make God love you more; and there is nothing you can do to make Him love you any less.

II. Confession.

- A. God will never accept an alibi for sin. (vs. 2-3)
- B. Confession of sin is to say the same thing God says about your sin. (I John 1:9; Prov. 28:13)
- C. Learn the difference between accusation and conviction.

III. Cleansing.

- A. Wash me. (vs. 2)
- B. Purge me. (vs. 7; I Jn. 1:9; Isa. 1:18)

IV. Consecration.

- A. You are cleansed to be put back on the track of service. (vs. 12-15)
- B. Do what you ought to do and you won't do what you are not to do.
