Newsletter Gleanings from **Biz Lерisse in the Dominican Republic/Haiti**

In July Beloved and I decided that we needed to have a regular and fun exercise program for our family. A few days a week we went to a huge empty field in our church village and we played some serious games of soccer. When the church children would see our car coming they would run to meet us at the field. We had one 16 year old boy, the son of a witch and voodoo priest, who began coming and after several weeks began attending the church services. One Sunday night after the service he called on Christ for salvation. He has been faithful every since.

The first week of August we held our first youth conference/camp for the Haitian churches in the DR. We had almost 60 young people. My wife & 29 girls slept at our house and the boys and I slept at the church. We had four days and nights of preaching and fun. Many, many young people made decisions as a result of this timely and powerful camp.

We have raised \$22,000 toward the \$55,000 needed for property. Our deadline is Dec. 5. Please pray with us concerning this project.
