Eternal Security is an awareness of God's guarantee that we are saved forever from the penalty of our sin.

(I Peter 1:3-5; Romans 10:13)

- I. How can we be confident our salvation is forever?
 - A. Salvation is eternal. (Heb. 5:9; 9:12)
 - B. We must choose to believe God's promise. (Jn. 14:1; I John 2:25; Heb. 10:22-23)
 - C. God's promise is greater than our doubt. (I Jn. 3:20; II Tim. 2:13)
 1. To doubt is normal. (Matt. 11:3)
 2. The devil will provoke us to doubt. (Gen. 3:1)
 - D. Confidence grows by our understanding and believing God's promise. (I Jn. 5:20; Rom. 10:17)
 - E. Salvation is not earned by works, kept by works, or lost by works. (Eph. 2:8-9; Titus 3:5; Isa. 64:6)
 - F. Our confidence is in whom we believe. (II Tim. 1:12)
 - G. We are confident of our salvation because the whole debt is paid. (Rom. 5:9; Heb. 10:14,18; Jn. 19:30)
- II. Can one lose their salvation?
 - A. No, there is nothing we can do to lose our salvation. (Jn. 6:37,10:29; Heb. 7:25)
 - B. No, because God cannot lie. (Titus 1:2)
 - C. God's Word says clearly we can know that we have eternal life. (I Jn. 5:12-13; Jn. 5:24)
 - D. God seals our salvation with the Holy Spirit (Eph. 1:13)
 - E. Our salvation is not determined by our feelings; it is determined by God's promises. (Rom. 8:1, 8:35-39; Jn. 10:27-29)
