Introduction

1. Music was God's idea. (I Sam. 13:14; I Chron. 16:5-7; Ps. 33:1; 150; Matt. 26:30; Eph. 5:19)
2. Music is included in more than just public worship services. (Ex. 32:17-18; Isa. 16:10; Matt. 11:17; Judges 11:34; Isa. 5:1)
3. God created us to enjoy both making and listening to music.
4. Questions to ask yourself about your music.
 - a. What motivates me to like the music I do?
 - b. Does the music I listen to affect my thoughts or behavior in any way?
 - c. Does it say anything about my relationship with God?
 - d. Are my music choices consistent with the gospel that has saved me?
5. How does music affect us?
 - a. It will affect our emotions.
 - b. Attentiveness can determine the way music will influence us.
 - c. The volume of music will affect us.
 - d. The familiarity of music will affect us.
 - e. Our background of music will affect us.
- I. The content of music. (Phil. 4:8; James 3:10; I Cor. 10:31)
 - A. Lyrics will weaken or strengthen our defenses.
 - B. Lyrics will blur or help focus our discernment.
 - C. Lyrics will redirect our affections to the world or set them on heaven.

There has been a lot going on around here despite "Holy Week" {which is a big deal in Guatemala - a very staunch Roman Catholic country.) We still went out and handed out thousands of Gospel tracts, Johns and Romans, and the new popular gospel witness "Living Stones". Our folks saw many professions of faith. Soon we will baptize new converts.

Our medical ministry is going well. I was able to lead a 67 year old lady to the Lord. Though she came with pain in her body, she has since been "healed" spiritually! We also continue seeing men and women make public professions of faith each time we preach and serve in a local rescue mission. God has allowed us to not only minister to their physical well being, but to minister most importantly to their souls with a week to week Bible study. Our class averages 45, but is "sadly" growing - after all, there is a serious problem in Guatemala City with drunkenness and drug abuse. God is able to save, heal and restore the down and out, so please keep us in our prayers!
