Newsletter Gleanings from **Mark Holmes**, missionary to Nigeria.

Starting on the last day of July, 3 youth camps were accomplished in 4 weeks with great results. S.M.I.T.E. (Student Missions Institute for Training in Evangelism) welcomed 460 campers from 51 churches; they took part in 88 Bible Clubs and enrolled 4,760 children to hear the Gospel! I was humbled by all the work that Berean Baptist Church of Ogbomosho, Truth Baptist Church of Nyanya-Abuja, and Indep. Baptist Church of Port Harcourt put into hosting, along with an ever-growing and hardworking group of faithful staff and graduates. We are now looking forward to the prospects of expanding to Ghana next year.

The middle of July brought me an opportunity to be the keynote at FBMI's Missionary Candidate School. It was 15 years ago that Sabrina & I attended our first candidate school. We credit much of our deputation successes to what we learned during that seminar. Joseph joined me this time around and attended his first-ever Youth Conference at First Baptist Church in Hammond. We were treated superbly by FMI and its staff, and I delighted in the chance to fellowship with veteran missionaries and to teach new candidates and those on deputation.
