I would like to introduce to you a faithful couple in our church, Simeon and Tanya, as they specifically need your prayers at this time. Tanya began coming to church in 2006. I was able to lead her to the Lord and she was baptized in December of 2007. I visited her husband Simeon soon after and talked to him about salvation, but he refused. He told me he liked to drink and wasn't ready to give up his alcohol. We began to pray for him and he began attending church around Christmas of 2008. Soon after, he accepted Christ and was baptized in April of 2009. Since then he has quit drinking and has been alcohol free for over 8 years. When he told his boss that he could no longer drink with him, he was fired a few weeks later. He has definitely grown in the Lord over these 8 years. Simeon had a stroke in September while out in a field with his goats. They found him a few hours later. He is now in rehabilitation and doing much better, but has a hard time walking and speaking clearly. Please pray for his complete recovery.
