Momentum. We love it when we have it; we work feverishly to try to get it back when it departs. We are very blessed to have some healthy momentum in the work right now.

A few months ago, we moved our Spanish Ministry over to the community where they all live. We are now seeing growth in attendance and in their personal involvement in the church. Adults make up nearly half of the crowd. They are starting to give, they are starting to invite neighbors, and they are getting involved. Our Brazilian congregation is starting to see more consistent growth as well. We have several families that are showing up each service. They, too, are starting to give regularly. We have had a family recently get baptized, and we have several folks who are consistent inviting and bringing visitors to church.

We held 2 Bible Clubs on consecutive days - one in Portuguese and one in Spanish. We had over 200 people attend, nearly 70 salvation decisions, and 3 different families visit the church the following Sunday. Two of those families have continued to attend since.
